Extra Time Club

At Activate Camps we understand many of you have work commitments that stretch beyond our normal camp start and finish times. Our Extra Time Club offers working parents a chance to drop children off early and collect later for a small daily fee.

Early drop off begins at 8.30am with latest collection at 5.30pm. (8:00am or 6:00pm at selected venues) ‘Extra Time Club’ offers a variety of structured activities in a relaxed environment for all age groups.

These extra hours sit outside of the ‘normal’ camp hours and are therefore not designed for the delivery of the core, sports specific or multi activity programme. Instead children will be offered a variety of different activities including a range from the following:

BrainBox Games – Our Extra Time Club partners BrainBox have provided us with educational and fun games to keep your children entertained during their extra time with us.

DVD’s - Aimed at the appropriate age for children who want to chill out and relax before camps start or when they finish.

Arts and Crafts - Options could include banner design, mask making,

Board and Garden games - Offer activities such as connect 4, twister, bowls and giant Jenga.

Group games or team building activities - Offer a selection of small games and ideas for groups of children to do either on their own or led by one of the camp staff, this might include multi sport, parachute games or similar activities.

These activities are supervised with the appropriate staff to child ratio, so it is essential you sign children into the club when booking or prior to the camp starting in order for us to have the correct number of staff available.
