Colour Blast Dash 2017

Event Rules & Guidelines

The Colour Blast Dash event rules and guidelines are applicable to all entrants, volunteers and the following event rules and guidelines are intended to help produce a happy, healthy event, to ensure the safety of all participants, to meet the requirements of local government permits. The Laura Centre retains the right to refuse entry to anyone declaring false information on their application, not making the required payment, or otherwise failing to meet the entry requirements. In any and all circumstances The Laura Centre retains the right to refuse entry to any person.

Terms & Conditions of Entry

PARTICIPATION

An email address is required for all entries. All correspondence will be via email. A separate email address for each participant is preferred but not required.

To register for the PKF Cooper Parry Colour Blast Dash you must be 16 years of age or older on event day. Entrants aged 4 to 15 must be entered by a parent/guardian and must be accompanied at the event by a parent/guardian.

Each participant must agree to the event waiver disclaimer and these terms and conditions before participating in the event. All participants take part at their own risk and a disclaimer waiving all claims against The Laura Centre and any party acting on its behalf must be completed by all entrants. Registrants must be capable of completing the full distance, start line to finish line.

By taking part, participants are in agreement for their names and any footage or photographs taken during their participation of Colour Blast Dash to be used to publicise any The Laura Centre events. Runner tickets and numbers are specific personal identifiers and cannot be exchanged with or sold to any other person. Transfers between runners can only be completed through contact with The Laura Centre office.

All entry fees are non-refundable, and cannot be deferred towards a future event. Entries are non-transferable. Registration closure is determined and announced when event participation reaches the established capacity or a pre-set date.

EVENT DAY

Participants must follow instructions as given from all event officials including race staff, volunteers, medical personnel, security officers and city officials throughout the duration of the event.

All participants are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner during their participation in the event. This means, for example, that urinating or defecating anywhere on or near the course shall be strictly prohibited except in toilet facilities. Anyone violating this rule of conduct shall be disqualified from the event and will be asked to leave the course.

Every participant shall be provided with an event runner number, which shall be conspicuously worn on the front during the event. The event runner number is to be worn as issued. No participant shall be permitted to participate in the event without the appropriate runner number.

All participants must write their name and details of any health problems or medication on the reverse of the runner number, which must be



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worn on the front of their shirt during the run.

During the Rascals Dash 4-15 event: baby joggers, baby strollers and wheelchairs, where the course route safely allows, are permitted on the course with the knowledge that these articles will be open to coloured powders and will be used at the owners own risk. Participants must begin the event during the official recognized starting times and in the interest of safety should start from the back of the group.

All participants must acknowledge and agree that personal information (including medical information entered on their run number or collected by event medical staff during or after the Event) can be stored, used and disclosed by The Laura Centre in connection with the organisation, promotion and administration of the event and for the compilation of statistical information.

THE START

Participants shall assemble for the Colour Blast Dash Warm up, 20 minutes prior to the run starting. Participants shall then proceed to the start line. All participants must be positioned behind the starting line when starting.

COURSE MONITORING

Any participant who refuses to obey the directions of the event official, city official or course marshal, or who conducts himself/herself in an unsportsmanlike manner, or who is offensive by action or language to officials, volunteers, participants or spectators may be disqualified by the event and future participation at the discretion of race officials.

Any person who participates in the event without a current official event runner number not officially assigned to him/her is subject to removal

by The Laura Centre.

No persons are authorized to be on the course unless they are registered participants (although access and through roads are available for park participants and cyclists). Children registered for the Rainbow Rascals race need to be accompanied, along with participants who are not physically/mentally able to complete the course alone.

PARTICIPANT SAFETY

Participants are responsible for their recognition and understanding of event signage, symbols and colour relating to participant maps, facilities and direction.

Medical personnel authorized by the event, may examine any participant who appears in distress. If in the sole opinion of authorized medical personnel it is in the best interest of the participant's health and welfare, medical personnel can remove the participant from the event. Participants must retire at once from the run if ordered to do so by a member of the event's official staff, official medical staff, or any governmental authority, including fire and police officers. Participants are responsible and assume liability for any and all medical expenses incurred as a result of training for and/or participation in the event, including but not limited to ambulance transport, hospital stays, physician and pharmaceutical goods and services.

Event officials reserve the right to delay, cancel, alter the route or suspend the event due to inclement weather in accordance with Emergency Protocol on severe emergencies and/or inclement weather. No refund will be issued in these circumstances.



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PRIVACY POLICY

All customers agree to our privacy policy when they enter an event, sign up as a volunteer, or sign up to our newsletter.

EXCEPTION

Any individual requesting a waiver of any of these rules from the event shall submit a written request no less than 30 days prior to the event date specifying the nature of and reasons for the request.

AMENDMENTS / RESERVATIONS / ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Event officials reserve the right, to modify, supplement or waive all or part of the event rules. Participants shall be bound by any modification or supplement of the event rules published prior to the event. Failure to follow these event rules can result in removal from the run.

Cancellation Policy

Customers with The Laura Centre have the right to cancel within 7 days of registration. Places can only be transferred following this time period where due notification is received so the appropriate details and waiver can be registered to the new applicant
